Each grade division will then send a representative to the Southeastern Wisconsin finals held **March 20** at West Allis Central High School - 8516 W. Lincoln Avenue - West Allis, WI

This program is part of a cooperative effort with the South East Park and Recreation Council (SEPRC).

Tournament Director: Tony Goodenough

Divisions: Boys and Girls in 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grades (separate boys & girls, and grade divisions)

Eligibility All shooters must be residents or attend South Milwaukee Schools. Also, if you participate in the South Milwaukee Recreation Department Basketball program you will be eligible for the free throw tournament.

Reporting All participants and spectators should report at the time listed above to the director. Participants should then complete the Official Entry Form/Score Sheet and remain in the seating area until directed to a specific basket for shooting.

Rules

- Participants will be allowed three warm-ups shots prior to the first round of free throws. No warm-ups will be allowed prior to the second round or the tie breaker series.
- Each participant will shoot a total of 40 free throws. Every shooter will shoot two, twenty shot rounds
- Total score of first and second shooting rounds will be tabulated for final count.
- In case of a tie 10 additional free throws will be taken.
- Participants arriving after the second round of free throws has begun will not be allowed to shoot.

No Open Gym - staff and participants are not to shoot before, after or during the tournament. All participants and spectators must remain quiet and behave in a sportsmanlike manner.

3rd and 4th grade divisions 27.5" Junior Ball

5th – 8th grade girls' divisions 28.5" Regulation Womens' Ball 5th – 8th grade boys' division 29.5" Regulation Mens' Ball

SHOOTING DISTANCE:

3rd – 4th grade: 10 foot 5th – 6th grade: 12 foot 7th – 8th grade: 15 foot

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place medals will be awarded in all divisions.

Finalists

Only the finalist from each grade division will represent South Milwaukee at the **SOUTHEAST PARK & RECREATION COUNCIL** (SEPRC) Tournament at West Allis Central High School on **Saturday, March 20.** If the SM winner cannot be present for the SEPRC Tournament, he or she must **immediately notify** the SM Recreation Department in order that an alternate may represent our community.
